This is a rock-pillar formed by erosion; it is composed of stratified agglomerates and tuffs.

Fig. 2. View of Takenoko-Iwa ("Bamboo Sprout Rock") at Uso, between Morizanē and Hizenya, Yabakei.

These rock-pillars are also composed of well stratified agglomerate and tuff beds.




Fig. 2.

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
