JSesh is both a hieroglyphic text editor, which follows quite closely the manuel de codage, and a java library for the manipulation of hieroglyphic texts. It is thus distributed with its complete sources, and a technical documentation.

To start JSesh, simply click on jsesh.jar (in the libs directory).

JSesh uses the following libraries:


- IText, a very complete pdf library for java (http://www.lowagie.com/ iText/); distributed under either the LGPL or the Mozilla public license.


