A Study of the Kanjin-ryakuyōshū

The Kanjin-ryakuyōshū 観心略要集 [KR] is a treatise which has been attributed to Genshin 源信 (942-1017), a Tendai priest who is famous as the author of the OjO-yōshū 往生要集. KR is an attempt to unify Pure Land Buddhism and the Tendai doctrine and contains some important ideas such as the theory of the Amida-sandai 阿弥陀三諦 (Amida as the Threefold Truth).

This study of the KR consists of three parts:

- I. Presentation of variants upon the text contained in the Eshinsōzu-zenshū.
- II. Notes on the KR, chiefly tracing quatations on their original sources.
- III. Some problems of the KR.

 - 2. The author of the KR.
